


PRINCE ALBERT GOLF AND CURLING CENTRE





The Prince Albert Golf & Curling Club provides a welcoming, accessible, year round environment for people of all ages and abilities to build friendships, sportsmanship and skill development through sports, social and leisure opportunities.

Prince Albert Golf & Curling Club is a non-profit community organization that is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors.. PAG&CC works in co-operation with the City of Prince Albert. The City of Prince Albert operates the golf course; PAG&CC owns & manages the building, the curling operation & the Rock & Iron Club House.

The Prince Albert Golf & Curling Club has a long history in the city. Curling started on the river in the 1800's, moving to various locations including 15th Street where the current Fire Hall stands, to our present location in 1968. Many provincial banners hang on our walls, recognizing the achievements of local curlers of all ages from youth to seniors.

Infrastructure is showing its age and there is continuing pressure put on the Club from athletes & participants for better & better ice & golfing conditions and facilities.



The club is active all year long – during


curling season there are leagues every weekday with many spiels & special events on the weekends. The leagues vary from juniors to seniors, from recreational to competitive. During the golfing season, daily golfers & tournament golfers use the PAG&CC Rock & Iron Restaurant & meeting rooms. PAG&CC continues to give curlers & golfers from juniors to seniors the opportunity to enjoy recreation & social events through the sports of curling & golf.
